<sup>1</sup> Administrative includes matters where the Crown proceeds summarily and the maximum is six months, and breach of probation, regardless of Crown election.

<sup>2</sup> Summary includes hybrids where the Crown proceeds summarily and maximum is six months.

<sup>3</sup> Indictable includes summary matters where minimum sentence is greater than six months, except for breach of probation. Includes unlawful confinement or abduction cases where the Crown proceeds summarily.

<sup>4</sup> Major level is all non-SCAP cases for the following offences: murder, attempted murder, manslaughter, aggravated sexual assault, sexual assault with a weapon or causing bodily harm, kidnapping, and dangerous and long-term offender hearings. Includes unlawful confinement or abduction cases where the Crown proceeds by indictment.

## Understanding the LSS Criminal Tariff Quick Reference

Section	Explanation

Tariff service provided	This is an alphabetical list of selected Criminal Tariff items.
Offence level	This section is divided into columns for each of the four offence levels (administrative, summary, indictable, and major) with sub-columns indicating the applicable fees and tariff codes. Where “n/a” appears, the service is not billable for that offence level.
Important – Selected billing rules	Items in the Criminal Tariff have comprehensive billing rules, only some of which are noted here. <b>It is important that you refer to the entire Criminal Tariff chapter for all billing rules before billing for services.</b>
